Family life fabrics are treated with two levels of stain protection. At the first level, spills are repelled and prevented from entering the fabric, so stains are easily removed. Should stains go unnoticed, eventually working into the fabric, a second barrier, with a proprietary releasing property, prevents most stains from becoming permanent. While the majority of spills can be easily removed, some oil based stains may not be completely removable.

Cleaning and Care Instructions

All spills should be treated promptly for best results and ease of removal.

Most spills can be cleaned by gently lifting the spill with a paper towel, or a clean, dry, absorbent cloth. If this does not completely remove the spill, use a water based soap mixture that combines 1 tablespoon of a liquid laundry detergent with 2 cups of warm water. Dampen the cleaning cloth in the mixture and gently blot the soiled area. Avoid rubbing the affected area aggressively. Rinse the area with a clean, damp cloth to ensure that all of the soap residue has been removed. Do not over wet the material. Pat dry with a second dry cloth. For stubborn stains, use a multi-purpose cleaner such as Woolite fabric and upholstery cleaner, and gently brush with a soft bristle toothbrush.

*Mustard, ink, oil, grease, lipstick, wax, pencil, crayon, and other oil based products may not be completely removable from Family Life fabrics.
*Permanent markers are designed to be non-removable, and therefore cannot be removed from Family Life fabrics.
*Do not use bleach to clean Family Life fabrics. This will result in discoloration of the fabric.

Cleaning and Care Instructions

Revolution fabrics are inherently stain resistant due to their 100% Olefin fiber (polypropylene) which does not allow a stain to penetrate the yarn. Olefin production uses the least energy and has the smallest carbon footprint of any fiber.



Loose stains like dirt, should be removed or vacuumed off before cleaning if needed.
Blot the stain with a clean cloth or paper towel to absorb as much of the spill as possible.
If the stain is in an area where the back of the fabric can be reached (like a zippered cushion), a towel should be placed on the back of the stained area to absorb excess moisture from cleaning.
Use a simple solution of 2 oz of dish soap plus 2 oz of bleach mixed with 1 gallon of water.
Wet a clean cloth in the cleaning solution, and gently rub the stained area, rinsing the cloth in the cleaning solution and repeating until the stain is gone. Rinse with clean water to remove any soapy residue.
Never use straight bleach.
DO NOT USE VACUUM ATTACHMENTS WITH ANY BRUSHES.
Air dry after cleaning.
Do not tumble dry and never expose the fabric to temperatures over 250 degrees Fahrenheit.
